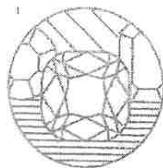

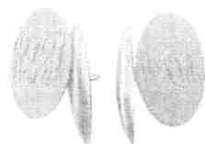

INSURANCE APPRAISAL



A PAIR OF ESTATE YELLOW GOLD CUFFLINKS

Hand assembled in 18 carat yellow gold, tested using XRF metal analysis.
Hallmarks: 18CT



Victorian era cufflinks, assembled with solid oval plates on a solid back plate with flat sides and hand engraved with the initials WGLM. The cufflinks are fitted with solid oval links and joined to a polished bullet back fitting. The front plates measure 20.22 x 13.00 x 0.75mm and the bullet back fittings measure 22.15mm in length and 4.50mm in width.

Item weight: 10.37 grams

Presented in very good condition showing minimal signs of wear.

Comments: The value is based on replacement for an item of similar era and quality in the current New Zealand second hand jewellery market.
