AN ANTIQUE YELLOW GOLD DOUBLE BELCHER CHAIN BRACELET

Cast component and hand assembled in 9 carat yellow gold, tested using XRF metal analysis.
Hallmarks: 9 C (Heart Padlock clasp: 9CT)

The double chain is assembled with round hollow faceted ornate belcher styled links measuring 6.50mm in diameter and round solid fluted embossed pattern round links measuring 6.50mm in diameter, all in alternating sequence. The double row of chain is soldered with a curved wire each end and joined to a Prince of wales knot each side flat heart padlock clasp and safety chain. The clasp measures 18.35 x 14.60 x 2.80mm. The overall bracelet length measures: 20.00cm.

Item weight: 25.77 grams

Presented in good condition showing slight signs of wear.

Comments: Being an antique article this item shows slight wear, care should be taken when being worn.

Comments: The value is based on replacement for an item of similar era and quality in the current New Zealand second hand jewellery market.
