Earrings Metal composition analysed as 9ct Red (Rosé) gold alloy, and stamped with 375 style hall/mark.

Earrings presented with Red (Rosé) gold, and fitted with (1) (single) and separate, cut-out and pierced, "in-situ" and "Scroll" design "Assembly" setting 6.78mm x 2.83mm x 3.40mm dimension type fittings, and "attached" to either earring.

Earrings presented with Red (Rosé) gold fittings "attached" to (1) (single) "Groove" design 0.86mm x 9.39mm dimension "Earwire" style "Assembly" setting, "solder" and separate and "attached" to either earring.

Earrings presented with Red (Rosé) gold, Elevated, with (1) (single) and separate Tahitian Cultured Pearl, and (1) (single) and separate "Cup" and "Peg" flush and "in-situ" style, and applied to 6.13mm diameter and "semi-scallop" and "Fluted" shape, central style mount "Assembly" setting, fitted and applied and placed to either earring.

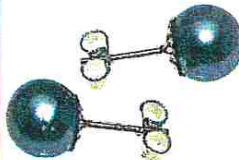

(Tahitian) and Cultured (half-drilled) Pearls presenting regular Spherical - slightly Out of Round shape, with high surface lustre, presented with Black - Greyish/Black and Body type colour, with Grey/Sea Green surface over-tone, and noticeable - surface blemishes, presented under (incandescent) light.

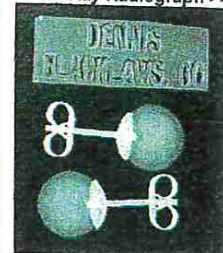
(Tahitian) and Cultured (half-drilled) Pearls presenting Thick- extra Thick 0.70mm - 0.80mm Nacre thickness.

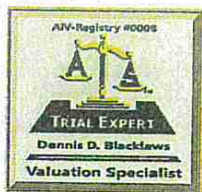

Tahitian Pacific COLOUR quality; POEMA sampler Grades;
(ABVVT 100/75) Grey Sea Green (Gris Vert Azur)

N.B. Check (1) (single) and (7.00cmØ x 5.00cm†) direct X-Ray radiograph.

N.B. Direct single X-Ray radiograph-examination indicate Pearls of (Beaded) (Cultured) and "Tahitian" origin.
For the purposes of this appraisal these (Pearls) graded as (Cultured) "Tahitian" origin.

It is an internationally accepted trade practice to treat Pearls, including Pearls of this variety, to enhance the Lustre, using traditional methods, i.e. polishing - although evidence of treatment is not immediately apparent in these Pearls. As present testing methods, as used by this Laboratory, may not detect the type of treatment applied, some may be assumed. This appraisal has been prepared ONLY on the basis that traditional Methods have been applied.
